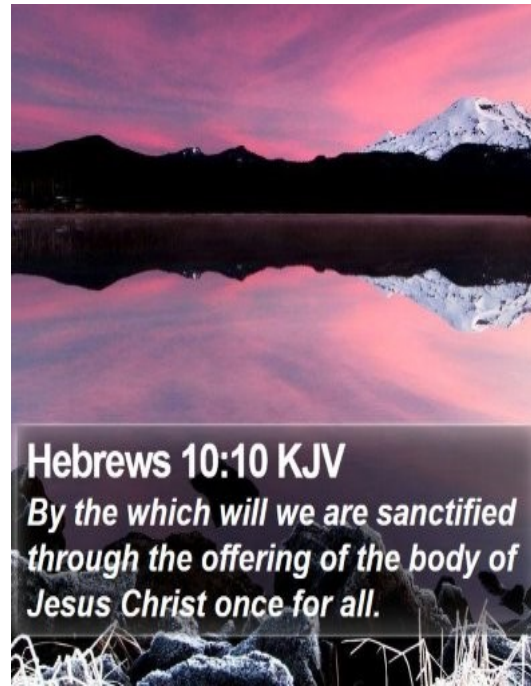

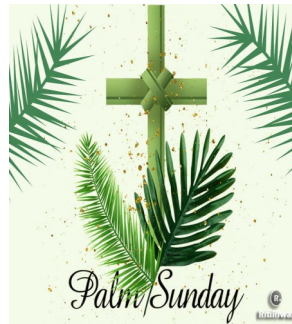


Choosing a new Archbishop
